1. **Opening Prayer** – An opening prayer commenced the meeting.
2. **Minutes of last meeting** - Minutes of previous meetings were agreed and adopted. Matters arising were discussed.
3. **Correspondence** - All correspondence was discussed by the Board including use of the school, recent circulars on Special Classes, Revision of Salaries, Special Education Teaching allocation and guidelines, staff arrangements for Voluntary Secondary Schools, School Book Scheme guidelines, National Consultation on Post-Primary Guidance, Climate Action Summer Works Scheme and the 2025 Summer Programme.
