BoM meeting of Ardscoil na Tríonóide was held on Tuesday 20th May 2025

Attendance/Apologies: Apologies noted.

1. **Opening Prayer** – An opening prayer commenced the meeting.
2. **Minutes of last meeting** - Minutes of previous meetings were agreed and adopted. Matters arising were discussed.
3. **Correspondence** - All correspondence was discussed by the Board including The Climate Action Summer Works Scheme, Revision of Salaries, Additional Posts of Responsibilities and Senior Cycle Redevelopment updates.
4. **Child Protection & Anti-Bullying** – The Child Protection Oversight Report and the Anti-Bullying report were presented to the Board. In addition to compliance reporting, a verbal report was provided to the Board on Anti-Bullying.
5. **Academic Calendar:** In light of the recently informed additional school closure days for staff professional development, the Board have asked staff to review the academic calendar for 2025-2026 in light of these dates.

 - Practical examinations took place in Junior Cycle Home Economics, Music, LC Art & Construction Studies along with LCVP.
 - A list of activities was noted and acknowledged including the Clothes Collection and the Parent Council Bake Sale, the CEIST Student Leadership Conference, Gaisce, Junk Kouture, First Year History tour.
